Maths

I can compare and order numbers up to 100 and
use < > =
I can read and write all numbers to 100 in digits & words
I can say 10 more/less than any number to 100
I can count in steps of 2, 3 & 5 from zero and in 10s
from any number (forwards and backwards)
I can recall and use multiplication & division facts
for 2, 5 & 10 tables
☐ I can recall and use +/- facts to 20
I can derive and use related facts to 100
I can recognise place value of any 2-digit number
I can add & subtract: 2-digit nos & ones, 2-digit
nos & tens, Two 2-digit nos & Three 1-digit nos

I can calculate and write multiplication & division
calculations using multiplication tables
I can recognise, find, name and write 1/3; 1/4;
