Dear Parents and Carers,

This week saw our magnificent Year 3 pupils take to the stage for their Spring Performance. They were absolutely brilliant and performed with great enthusiasm and skill. Well done to all the children and adults who helped create such a great show.

It has also been another week disrupted by Industrial Action and the school remains very grateful for the support, understanding and patience shown by our parent community. These are very difficult decisions for the teachers and we all share the frustration that the government and the unions seem no closer to agreeing a fully funded pay offer.

The months of May and June mean National Testing for different year groups at Lauriston. Our Year 1 pupils will take the Phonics Screening Check in June; our Year 2 pupils will take the KS1 SATs during May; our Year 6 pupils will take their KS2 SATs between 9<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> May and our Year 4 pupils will take the Multiplication Tables Check during June.
